


## Pioneer Program Game

## Hopscotch

Hopscotch is a game that pioneer children would have played with their friends, and today we are going to learn how to play!



Step 1: Using chalk, draw a hopscotch design (like in the picture) on cement.

The squares should be large enough to fit one foot into.

Step 2: Throw a rock into square one. It has to land inside the square without touching the border or bouncing out, or you lose your turn.

Step 3: Hop through the squares, skipping the one your rock landed in. When you have two squares next to each other (like #4 & #5 in the picture), put one foot down in each square.

Step 4: When you get to square #10, turn around (staying on one foot) and hop your way back.

Step 5: While you're on the square before the one with the rock, bend down and pick it up. Then, skip over that square (without putting your foot in it) and finish up the round.

Step 6: Pass the rock on to the next person. If you completed the course with your rock on square one without losing a turn, then throw your rock onto square two on your next turn, and so on until it has landed on each square.

Step 7: Your goal is to complete the course with the rock landing in each square. The first person to do this wins!

Hey kids! Bucky the beaver here to remind you that if you step on a line, hop on the wrong square, or step out of the square, you lose your turn.
